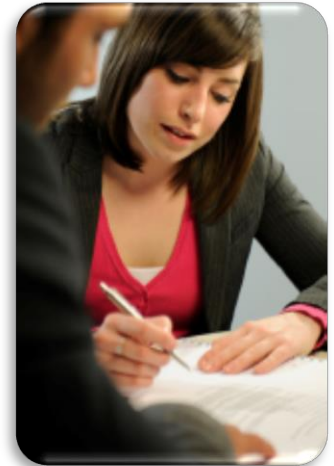

Work Experience and Internship Placements

We can help place you in a variety of work or volunteer opportunities in New Zealand.

- Volunteer Work Placement
- Internship Programme (unpaid) *
- Job Placement (paid) *
- Seasonal Work/Vineyard Work Placement
- WWOOF Organic Farms Registration (approx. \$40 registration fee)
- Au Pair / Demi Pair Placement *

Conditions:

* Placement in paid or unpaid positions: \$250 - \$800 placement fee may apply.

This service is available for students from 18 years and over.

In order to get a paid job, it is essential to hold a valid work permit or working holiday visa. Student visa holders must study for a minimum of 14 weeks to be allowed to work up to 20 hours per week.

The type of work experience assigned to each student depends on the student's English ability, employer's requirements, experience and interest.

We will try our best to find work experience which matches the specific requirements of each student, but a placement cannot be guaranteed.
