Terms & Conditions:

- NZLC will confirm which schedule will run (Schedule 1 or Schedule 2) by 3 September 2021 via email
- Limited spaces are available (maximum 16 students per class). Students will be allocated on a first come first served basis
- A \$100 deposit is required to reserve a place on the course
- Attendance is counted throughout the course. Students that are more than 15 minutes late will be counted as absent
- The deposit is refundable to students with a minimum of 80% attendance
- No cancellation is accepted once the course commences. In special circumstances, a student may be given a refund after the course has started, but this is entirely at the discretion of NZLC
- The schedule is subject to change
- A graduation certificate will be awarded for completion of the course with a minimum of 80% attendance

If the COVID-19 alert level changes:

- NZLC Auckland will run the CELTA course onsite at Alert Level 1 & 2 and online at Alert Level 3 & 4. Teaching practice, however, cannot be delivered online without adequate preparation for both trainees and students, so we will continue this component of the course once the school has re-opened. In this case, the course would be extended beyond the initial five weeks in order to make sure that the teaching practice is completed.
- If Auckland moves to Alert Level 3 or 4 during the first week, the course will be postponed. The new start date will be the closest Monday after we move back to Alert Level 1 or 2.
