TOEIC (Test of English for International Communication) is an English language proficiency test for non-native speakers.

This elective covers the TOEIC listening and reading tests. You will practice one part of the test each week, followed by an in depth analysis of that part, learning about and practicing the necessary subskills and language to help you pass the test successfully. These skills are also transferrable and can be applied to real life and other tests.

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
